

## Paintball Outing Information Guide

### What To Wear For A Paintball Game.



If you have it, wear camouflage. If you don't, then wear clothing with earth- tone colors. Wear loose shirts and pants. Dark colored worksuits or jumpsuits work great. No SHORTS are allowed. Always wear long sleeve shirts. The forest is unkind to exposed skin. In cold weather wear several loose layers of clothing. Loose clothing insulates and protect nicely. A sweatsuit outfit as a bottom or middle layer is perfect. The hood will cover your head. Wear sturdy work shoes, boots or a very supportive athletic shoe. Open toe footwear like sandals are NOT allowed. The terrain will be rough and sometimes very wet and slippery. If playing during bug season bring insect repellent. Use the rub-on instead of the spray. Spray Insect repellent ruins goggle lenses. The fields may be muddy. You might want to bring a change of clothes or seat covers for the ride back home.

### How Much Money Should You Bring?

Depending on your group size and organization your money expenditure will differ. If you are in a private game you will need to contact your organizer and find out what your share of the game fee is. Bring a valid State ID or drivers license to secure rental equipment. Open game player fees will vary based on if you have pre-purchased your admissions and whether or not you need to rent equipment. The fees typically cover gun rental, field use, and goggles. We do offer packages that include paintballs too. If you have never played the game before, you can estimate that you will shoot a minimum of 500 rounds for a short outing. If you play for at least half a day you will possibly shoot 500+ paintballs for the day. You may shoot more or less depending on your individual experience, length of stay, and participation in the games. A new players overall average cost for a full day of paintball is approximately \$55 to \$70.
